Thanks for your very interesting letter of April 10th, and I will be happy to forward to you bits of information that will be of interest to you as I dig them up.

In "The People's Guide," a Boone County directory published in 1874, I find listed on Page 230 in the Jackson Township section:

"Deweese, Simon P.; farmer; 1½ m e Jamestown. Born in Ind. 1834; settled in B. C. 1834. Dem."

No other listings of this name are to be found elsewhere in this directory.

I have located the graves of Isaac and Sarah (Boyd) Powell as being in the center of a small tilled field on a farm now owned by Marion and Dorothy Swinford in Clinton Township. The field is in the morthwest quarter of the morthwest quarter of Sec. 11, Twp. 19North, R1East. An 1878 map of the township shows this bit of ground as being a rectangular 10 acre tract owned by W. W. Watson. It was on the north side of an east-and-west road. Cornering it on the southwest corner was 40 acres lying south of the road and in the northeast corner of Sec. 10, owned by J. Watson, and this 40 acres is now owned by Marion and Dorothy Swinford. Marion Swinford lives at 1916 N. Bolton, Indianapolis, Indiana.

By phone I talked with his father, Thornton Swinford, who lives in the neighborhood. Mr. Swinford told me that some time ago a Lebanon high school teacher, (a woman) and some boys removed the slab marker which was lying on the ground at the site of the graves, and I will make an affort to find where the slab is now. The elder Swinford said that the plot is being farmed over but that he knew the location of the graves. He said Marion would not be adverse to permitting the site to be fenced but that he felt some of the descendents of the Powells should take this action. The elder Swinford said as he recalled hearing the story, the two Powells died within a matter of a few days of each other, of cholera, and were hastily buried on the farm on which they lived. He felt that it was a shame that the graves of these two old pioneers should suffer the neglect that they have.

The two churches you mentioned, Old Union, in Jackson Two., and Pleasant View, in Jefferson Twp., are still in existence and are still holding services. I cannot say as to Pleasant View's cemetery records, but those of Old Union are pretty sketchy as to early burials.

You mentioned finding a James Stark in the 1830 census of Nicholas County, Ky. My. great-great-great grandfather, Joseph Stark, emigrated from Virginia in 1785, to Shelby County, Ky., and later removed to Henry Co., Ky., where he died in 1821. Family records name but three of Jsceph Stark's children, Abner, Phillip, and Caleb, and it is possible that the James Stark was another son of Jeseph Stark's.

In the early 1920's, I was a reporter for the Lebanon Reporter, and one of my daily chores was the writing of obituaries. It was quite noticeable then in the life hisocries of persons dying in their late 70's and in their 80's, the mention of Nicholas Co., Ky., either their parents or grandparents having come to Indiana from that Kentucky county.

I do quite a lot of research in local hisotry and once in a while "write-up". something of particular interest for the Lebanon Reporter, so am enclosing a story published recently which may be of some interest to you.

And, if you can find it convenient to do so, I would appreciate carbons of your "pickings" from the 1850 and 1840 census lists as pertaining to Boone County.

My sincere thanks for your mailings some three weeks ago of additional early Boone County census names. I have delayed answering in an effort to find out more about the removal of the stones from the Isaac Powell burial plot.


Last evening I talked with Lloyd Quick, who, as a 17 year old junior in the Lebanon high school twelve years ago, brought in one small weathered marbel slab from the plot to the school, at the request of his history teacher, Miss Lillian Witt, now deceased.

Quick told me the slab was cleaned up and the inscription deciphered. He said that as he faintly remembered, the slab marked the grave of an infant. He said that when he found the stone while assisiting with grain harvesting on the farm, the man then on the farm knew nothing of the burials and was unaware of the grave site. Quick said he believed he returned the slab to the plot, but wasn't sure. He did not remember of any other markers at the place. If he did return the stone, it may be about the place yet, but I doubt if it was returned. I doubt if it is now in existence.

Another young man who once farmed the tract, told me he could locate the plot with reasonable certainty, and that he had removed the tree that once grew there. I have been unable to contact Mr. Marion Swinford, present owner of the farm as yet. If I learn any thing further will let you know.

I haven't been down to the Historical Library yet; hope to make it next week. Will then check on the Powells in the Hendricks County books.



POWELL FAMILY RECORDS

(Compiled by Mrs. Robert Potts)

Information from the Indiana State Library in regard to A. Pauly and Jonathan Martin found in the Powell Church records, Indian Grove, MO., who baptized the Powell family:

"We have found some information in *Early Life and Times in Boone County Indiana*, compiled by Harden & Spahr, Lebanon, Ind., 1887. Arice Pauly was a deacon in Pleasant View Church, which was organized in Jefferson Township, Boone County, in 1836 (p. 222-225). Jonathan Martin was a minister in the Old Union Church, which was organized in 1838 in Jackson Township, Boone County, nine miles southwest of Lebanon, Indiana. Neither of these churches is still active, (1959) according to the Indiana Baptist headquarters office here in Indianapolis. They are sorry that they do not know where or if the old records are still in existence."

THE FAMILY OF THOMAS POWELL OF NICHOLAS CO., KENTUCKY

By Mrs. Robert Potts (Marna Powell Potts)

To date, our Powell's have, been traced to **Thomas Powell**, born about 1755, either in Maryland or England. The book, "*Pioneer Families of Missouri*", published in 1876, states that he and his wife, **Nancy Chaney**, were natives of Maryland and settled in Nicholas Co., Ky., in 1796. The book, "*Early Life and Times of Boone Co., Indiana*", published in 1887, states that **Thomas Powell** and his wife came from England. Census records show that one of their sons was born in Va. in 1777, and another one in Pa. in 1779. We do not know yet exactly where they lived before coming to Nicholas Co., or who the parents of either one were. **Thomas Powell** died Oct. 18, 1813, and his wife, **Nancy**, died Sept. 1, 1835. They were the parents of ten children as follows:

- MARY (POLLY) POWELL: Probably the oldest, but date of birth not known, She married Samuel Foster and moved to Ohio. No further data available.
- <u>WILLIAM POWELL:</u> Died March 27, 1813, leaving a widow and several children. Had 3 boys and 2 girls in 1810 census. No record of his descendants available.
- THOMAS POWELL, JR.: born between 1773-1784, died Feb. 28, 1818 in Nicholas Co. Married Mary (Polly) Caldwell., Nov. 114., 1805, dau. of William Caldwell. (She later married David Evans and went to Boone Co, Ind.) One son went to Montgomery Co., Md., another to area of Audrain or Galloway Co., Ma. Bible records for this family located and copied. Daughter Matilda married a Brenton
- **JOHN POWELL**: born Feb. 27, 1777 in Va., died April 24., 1862 in Rush Co., IN. Married Sarah Caldwell, Apr. 19, 1804. Descendants lived in Rush & Boone Co., IN. *Bible records for this family located and copied*.
- **NANCY POWELL:** born ca. 1790-94, married Wm. Richart.
- <u>CHARLES POWELL</u>: born ca. 1779 in Pa., married Nary (Polly) Harrah Feb. 5, 1801 in Montgomery Co, Ky. Stayed in Nicholas Co., Ky.
- **ISAAC POWELL:** born ca. 1780, died 184.3 on his farm in Clinton twp. Boone Co, IN. Possibly a vet, of the war of 1812. Wife was Sarah Boyd.
- <u>JEREMIAH (JERRY) POWELL:</u> born 1788, died Sept. 28, 1814.5 in Edgar Co., Ill. Married Martha (Patsy) Fleming, Nov. 29, 1808. Lived near Paris, Ill. *Bible records located and copied.* (no copies here in my records- J. Engelke)

NANCY POWELL; born 1790-94

ROBERT POWELL, born 1794, died Aug. 19, 1877 at his home near Mexico, MO., in Audrain Co. Vet. of War of 1812. Married 1st, Celia Murphy, June 8, 1815; 2nd, Mary Ann Howe, Aug.28, 1848; 3rd, Mary Ann Hart, Dec. 25, 1849. *Bible records located and copied.* (no copies in my records-JE)

DAUGHTER: died early

I, Samuel Chaney, of the County of Bourbon, State of Kentucky, do own myself to be indebted to **Thomas Powell**, County and State aforesaid for which consideration I do assign over to the said **Thomas Powell** all the goods and chattels now in my possession, namely:

1 black mare with a blazed face, a bay filly rising 2 years old, 1 cow, & 1 steer, 3 years old this spring, 4 yearling? & 4 calves, 70 bushels of corn The meat of 4 hogs, Pot & oven & shotgun. 1 hoe, a sow & 6 shoats

2 cows & 6 shoats running at the mouth of Little Flat.* The shoats is marked with a crop off the left and upper bit, and one slit in right.

Which the said **Powell** is to have and to hold, his heirs, executors and administrators, from hence forth as his own property with his own proper goods and chattels.

In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 26th day of January 1799.

This indenture made the 23rd of December in the year of our Lord 1805 between Cornelius Hall and Sarah, his wife, of the County of Nicholas and State of Kentucky of the one part and **Thomas Powell** of the County and State aforesaid witness that the said Cornelius Hall and Sarah, his wife, for and in consideration of 45 pounds current money of the state aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presence doth bargain, and release and confirmed unto this said Thomas **Powell**, his heirs and assigns forever, part of a tract of land situated on the Waters of Sommersett Creek, county and state aforesaid which tract was conveyed to the said Hall by John Boyd, to John Boyd by Curtis Medkiff, to Curtis Medkiff by Curtis Medkiff, to Curtis Medkiff by Thomas Franklin, to Thomas Franklin by James Abercrombie by his deed dated the 16th day of December 1784 as reference thereto being (had will?) fully appear containing 1000 acres, being part of a tract of land surveyed by James Abercrombie, containing 1400 Acres and in the general plat of the subdivision marked No. 2, adjoining lands of Powell on the southeast and John Lyall on the Northwest, beginning at a buckeye and ash running thence east 184 poles to 3 sugar trees, thence south 44 west 148 1/4 to a poplar and ash, thence north 46 west 108 poles to the beginning containing 50 acres together with all the woods, ways, watercourses, herediments, and all the appurtenances in any wise there—into belonging to the proper use and behoove of him the said Thomas Powell, his heirs, assigns, executors r administrators. From them, the said Cornelius Hall and Sarah, his wife, their heirs and assigns, and win warrant and defend the same from each and every person unto the said Thomas Powell, his heirs and assigns forever, and that at any time hereafter they will at the request of the said Powell make and execute and acknowledge any such deed or conveyance as shall be deemed requisite for the better insurance and confirmation of the said granted tract.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written, Cornelius Hall, Nicholas County, 27th of January 1806. This deed of bargain end sale from Cornelius Hall and wife to **Thomas Powell** was acknowledged before me the date above by the said Cornelius Hell according to law and duly recorded. And on the 14th of July following, personally appeared before me, Sarah Hall, wife of the within named Cornelius Hall, and being examined as the law requires relinquished her right of dower to the lands within conveyed and desired that the same may be recorded.

This indenture made and entered into in the year of our Lord 1831 on the 16th day of May, between Jeremiah Powell of tie county of Nicholas and State of Kentucky of the one part, and we, Robert Powell and his wife, Sela, John Powell and his wife Sally, Charles Powell and his wife Polly, and Samuel Foster and Polly, his wife, the other part witnesseth; the last party being heirs and representative of Thomas Powell, deceased. They have this day for and in consideration of one dollar to them paid in hand by the said Jeremiah Powell, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. Both granted, bargained and sold and so by these presents bargain and sell unto the said Jeremiah Powell, all their right title claim and interest to a certain tract or parcel of undivided land which the said heirs hold an interest in as the heirs of Thomas Powell, deceased, lying being and situated in the county and state uforesaid on the Waters of Sommerset and Abercrembies survey and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a Buckeye and Ash running thence East 184 poles to three Sugar trees, thence South 44 degrees west 184½ poles to a Poplar and Ash, thence North 46 West 108 poles to the beginning, containing 50 acres. To him the said **Jeremiah Powell** his heirs and assigns to have and to hold forever, from thence the said **Robert Powell**, his wife **Seles**, and all the other party their heirs and assigns forever. They further warrant and forever defendall claims set up to said tract or pared of land by through or In their names: but no other claim or claims whatever. In witness whereof the said parties has hereunto set their ha,nds and seals this date first Written.

Brant & Fuller, Chicago, publishers. P. 422:

John M. Powell, a prominent farmer of Jackson Twp. was born in Nicholas Co., Ky., November 5, 1824. His parents were **John** and **Sarah Powell**, the former a native of Virginia, and the latter of Kentucky. In 1832 they migrated to Rush Co. and settled 3 ½ miles northwest of Rushville, in Rushville Twp. Where they purchased a tract of wild land. There **John** and **Sarah Powell** continued to reside until their respective deaths. They were among the first settlers of Rush Co., and did their share while here toward its development.

Our subject has spent the principal part of his life here, and adopted farming as a life profession, which, at the age of 24 he began for himself. On Nov. 11, 1856 he was married to **Mary E. Porter**, daughter of William and Catherine Porter, deceased pioneers of this county. Mrs. Powell was born in Rush county in 1838, and has always resided here. This union has been blessed with three children: Homer, Olive, and Huldah, all of whom are married and residing within a few miles of the old farm.

Politically, **Mr. Powell** is a staunch Republican, but has never sought political honors. We began life as a poor man, and by din (?) of industry and perseverance has been eminently success ul (?). He has provided each of his children with a farm, and now owns 360 acres of first class farming lands. His home place consists of 120 acres, and is provided with good improvements. He has been a hard working man all through life, and has set a good example for his children to follow. He expects now to end his days in Rush Co. where he has spent the best part of his life in making a comfortable home. An honest and upright man, he is respected by all, and can be classed among the successful farmers of Jackson Township.

JAMES A. POWELL PENSION RECORD

James A. Powell enrolled Oct 7, 1861 with Co. F., 40th Reg., Indian Ind., and was discharged Jan. 31, 1863. On the same day he was again signed to Co. E, and was discharged Feb. 1, 1865 as Sgt., at Vicksburg, Missouri.

On June 30, 1862, the record shows that he was sick at Corinth and at Nashville, Tenn., where he was treated from diarrhea.

It is not known exactly when he applied for a pension, but on April 3, 1915, he filled out a questionnaire giving the following information:

Place of birth: Clinton Twp., Boone Co., Indiana.

On May 10, 1924, **James A. Powell**, age 81, stated that he was born August 15, 1842 in Boone Co., Ind. His personal description: height, (?) ft., 10 ½ in.; complexion, light; eyes, blue; hair, auburn; occupation, farmer. Since service, has resided in Boone Co., Ind., and has been farming.

Since Feb. 1, 1923, he stated that he has had the following disabilities: chronic diarrhea, piles, kidney & bladder trouble, bad heart, very bad nervous system, very short of breath, slow in walking, and hardening of arteries. His witnesses were E. D. Worrell, Lebanon, and (?). E. Rammel, Lebanon.

At the time of his death, Oct. 22, 1926, he was receiving \$72.00 monthly pension checks.

Page 347:

"ISAAC POWELL was born in Nicholas County, Kentucky in 1780. He was married to Sarah Boyd in the above county, remained there until the year 1835, when he came to Boone County, Indiana. His parents were from England, and came to Kentucky in an early day, where they were pioneers, indeed.

Isaac Powell died in the year, 1843, and was buried on the farm where he settled, now known as Watson farm. Sarah Powell, his wife, died in 1858, and was buried at the same place.

The following are the names of the family: Ann, Mary, Martin, Charles, Sarah, Marina, Elizabeth, Martha, **William C**., Eliza, and Jeremiah. Five of the above are now (in 1887) living in Boone Co., viz: Martin, Marina Stephenson, Sarah McCann, Elizabeth, and **William C. Powell.**

This is one of the early families of the county, as well as the largest. William C., who is one of the best citizens of Clinton Township, furnished the above facts of his father's family, is a resident of Clinton Township, where he owns a fine farm."

"Clinton Township is in the East center and in the North tier of townships adjoining Clinton County. Sugar Creek enters at the N. W. corner. Mud Creek and Brown's Wonder flow through the township in a N. W. direction and empty into Sugar Creek. Clinton township was first settled in 1834 by the following: William West, Jesse Perkins, George Lognett, J. A. McDaniel, John Evans, Obid Hardisty, and Hiram Powell."

"Jackson Township is in the S. W. corner of Boone Co., bounded by Hendricks Co. on the South, and Montgomery Co. on the West; and on the North by Jefferson township, and on the East by Harrison and Center townships. Early settlers who came about 18?8 (can't read)were: Young Hughes, Lewis DeWeese, John & Washington Gibson, William Farlow, Isaac Miller, and others. They were later joined by S. P. DeWeese."

Isaac Powell, 5th son of **Thomas Powell** and **Nancy Chaney** of Nicholas Co. Kentucky, was born about 1780, possibly in PA. He was married in NY sometime between 1810-1812 to **Sarah Boyd**. In 1835, they migrated to Clinton Township. Boone Co., Indiana. **Isaac** died in 1843, and 4 years later, on Dec. 9, 1847, his widow, **Sarah**, married Jasper Vidito (a widower). There were no children by this second marriage. Both **Isaac** and **Sarah** are buried on their farm in the northeast part of the county near Elizaville, IN. A brief biography of this family is printed on page 347 in the book, "Early Live and Times of Boone Co., Indiana", pub, 1887 by Harden and Spahr.

OBITUARY OF ROBERT M. POWELL

From The Lebanon (IN) Patriot, August 11, 1904:

Robert M. Powell, a pioneer citizen who had lived in Boone county sixty-four years, died Monday morning at 9 o'clock at the advanced age of more than 89 years. Death was due to senile debility. Mr. Powell was a native of Nicholas County, KY. A wife and the following children survive him: Thomas M., Milroy, and George M. Powell, and Mesdames Ida Stout and Bessie Ritchie, all of Boone Co; Patsy M. Bowen, of Nebraska, William E. Powell and Almarinda Williams, of Texas, Nancy M. Richmond, of Marion county, and Daly Powell, of Ansonia, Kansas. There also survive him, one sister, Mrs. Sarah McCann, of here. Mr. Powell was a member of the Christian church. Funeral services and interment at Pleasant View yesterday at 10 a.m.

OBITUARY OF ISAAC MARTIN POWELL

(Son of Robert Martin, above)

From The Lebanon Pioneer, Nov 27, 1902:

Another pioneer, Isaac Martin Powell, died at his home on north East street at 4:30 o'clock p.m. last Sunday, from stomach trouble. He had been indisposed for two or three years and for more than a year his condition was regarded as critical. He had a large acquaintanceship and was everywhere favorably known. He had been a resident of Boone County for more than sixty years, and his influence always went for what was the best.

Mr. Powell was born in Lawrence County, Indiana, October 18, 1839, and was consequently aged sixty-three years, 1 month and six days. He came with his parents to Boone County at an early age. His parents settled in Clinton Township and in 1855 moved to Center Township. Mr. Powell had resided on the farm in this township since the date up to within two years ago when he moved to Lebanon.

He was married in the spring of 1861 to Miss Anna McCann, daughter of William and Sarah McCann. He was the father of six children, four of whom survive him: Mrs. Hattie Cronon who lived at Noblesville; Mrs. Wallace Ellis, who resides near Elizaville; Albert, who lives on the home farm; and Carrie, who resides at home.

Mr. Powell served for a short time in the Civil war in the 135th Indiana Regiment. He was a member of the G.A.R., and also of the Red Men's lodge. He was a member of the Central Christian Church.

He leaves surviving him besides his father and mother, Mr. and Mrs. Robert M. Powell, the following brothers and sisters: Mrs. patsy Bowen, of Missouri; Thomas J. Powell, of this city; William E. Powell, of Ft. worth, Texas; Mrs. Almarinda Williams, of near Ft. Worth, Texas; Mrs. Nannie Richmond, of Indianapolis; Roy Powell; of Jefferson township; Dallie Powell, of Ohio; George Powell, of Center township; Mrs. Bessie Richey, of Lebanon; Mrs. Charles Stout, of Jefferson township.

The funeral was conducted from the house at eleven o'clock, Tuesday morning, Rev. A. J. Frank officiating. Burial at Oak Hill cemetery.

ISAAC MARTIN POWELL

(data found in his Civil War Pension file in Wash., D.C.)

Isaac M. Powell enlisted April, 1864, as Pvt. in Co. F., 135th Reg. of IN Vols., commanded by Capt. Robert A. Williamson. He was discharged at Indianapolis, Sept 29, 1864. His personal description at time of enlistment: Age, 24 years; height, 5 ft 11 ½ in.; complexion, light; hair, light; eyes, blue, while in the service, he was stationed near Stevenson, Alabama, in June, 1864.

On March 10, 1888, he first applied for a pension at the age of 48. His partial disability was rheumatism in back, arms, legs and shoulders, which he contacted from exposure to rains and other privations while in the service. He had never since been able to perform hard manual labor. He lived in Center Township, Boone Co., IN, and had been a farmer since discharge, but partially disabled because of rheumatism.

His two witnesses to the above application were William Hawkins and John H. Perkins. Apparently the pension was granted.

On January 15, 1898, he was asked to fill out a questionnaire and gave the following information: his wife was Ann Eliza McCann, whom he married April 7, 1861, at her home, by Elder Vandake, of Lebanon, IN. Neither had previously been married. They had four children living: Walter H., born March 30, 1866, Icy J., born June 3, 1876, William Albert born Feb. 20, 1882, and Carrie E. born April 2, 1889.

Isaac I. Powell died Nov 23, 1902, at which time his quarterly payments of \$14.00 were terminated.

On Dec 4, 1902, his widow, Ann E. Powell, age 58, and a resident of the city of Lebanon, Boone Co., IN, applied for a widow's pension. She stated that she still had one child under 16 years of age, Carrie E., born April 2, 1889. She also enclosed a copy of her marriage certificate to Isaac M. Powell.

On Nov 28, 921, she again applied for a widow's pension, this time as the widow of Thomas M. Small, whom she stated that she married march 21, 1905, at Lebanon, by Rev. L. E. Brown. She further states that she was first married to Isaac M. Powell, who died 21, 1921, at Lebanon, Annie E. Small was at this time 78 years old.

She stated that Thomas M. Small enlisted Sept 18, 1861, at Lebanon, IN, as corporal in Co. I, 10th Reg., IN. vols., and was discharged Sept 19, 1864. She signed her name, "Anna E. Small", 504 North East St., Lebanon, IN. Her witnesses were Charles T. Warren, Lebanon, and Clara E. Stewart, Lebanon.

A copy of some of the papers of Thomas M. Small were included also. On May 17, 1921, he stated that he was 80 years old, lived in Lebanon, IN, and that his personal description at the time of enlistment was as follows: height, 5 ft. 11 in.; complexion, dark; eyes, black; hair, black; occupation, farmer; was born Jan 8, 1841 in Nicholas Co., KY, had lived in IN ever since the close of the War. His ailment: chronic neuphritis, failing eyesight, vertigo and feebleness of age.

Margaret A. Allen, fifth child of Angeline (Powell) and Robert Allen married her first cousin, Milton Powell, fifth child of Chas. E. Powell. They lived near Indian Grove, MO.

Only three children of this marriage survived to adulthood. In 1880 typhoid claimed the life of their 7 yr old boy and in less than 3 weeks the mother too was buried beside her children in the Powell cemetery, which ground she and her husband had donated to the church in 1877. Typhoid fever claimed the lives of several of our relatives buried here including Milton's 19 yr old sister, Josie Powell in 1883 and also several nieces and nephews. Milton shortly thereafter married Edwina Bashaw, had and lost anther baby who was also buried in the same plot in 1882. Discouraged and grief-stricken, Milton finally moved the remainder of his family to Appleton City, MO where he later had other children. The story of Milton Powell and his family may be found under child # 5 of Chas. E. Powell & Lydia West.

Obituary of Isaac J. Allen, 1939

Isaac J. Allen, son of Robert and Angeline Allen was born at Lebanon, Boone Co., Indiana, March 3, 1856, and passed away at his home in Sumner Mo., May 21, 1939 at the age of 83 yrs., 2 months and 18 days. When 22 years of age he came to Mo. From Indiana and on Sept 29 1878 was married to Clarissa A. DeWeese. To this union was born 12 children. Mr. Allen spent all his life since coming to MO. In the vicinity of Indian Grove and Sumner. When a young man he united with the Powell Christian Church and has live an honorable upright life. Funeral services were held at the Powell Church. Burial was in Powell Cemetery.

Obituary of Clarissa A. (DeWeese) Allen, 1949

Clarissa A. Allen, daughter of Rev. Carter and Nancy DeWeese was born Sept 26, 1862 in Lebanon, Indiana and passed away May 26, 1949 at the age of 86 years, and 8 months. She came to Mo. with her parents at the age of 5 and lived near Indian Grove until she and Isaac Allen were married. When a young woman, she united with the Powell Church. Funeral services was held at the Powell Church. Burial in Powell cemetery.

Isaac J. Allen was the eleventh child of Angelina Powell and Robert B. Allen. Angelina was the first child of Isaac & Sarah (Boyd) Powell of Boone Co., IN.

Clarissa A. (DeWeese) Allen was the first child of Rev. Carter DeWeese and Nancy E. (Powell) DeWeese who was the third child of Charles E. Powell and Lydia (West) Powell. Charles E. Powell was the fourth child of Isaac and Sarah (Boyd) Powell. This couple were first cousins once removed.
